Some memories about Lali:

- Piski Lajos Arnold born on April 30, 1991 left this world, at just 28 years old, he died, February 18, 2020 Tuesday morning, at 10:00 am following a myocardial infarction and respiratory failure.
- He practiced shotokan karate at the Oradea Shogun Performance Center, from the age of 11, has been active as a high performance athlete for 10 years until senior years, later he became a national school karate referee.
- After karate, Lali made the step towards the Faculty of Geography, Tourism and Sport at the University of Oradea, the Department of Physical Education, Sport and Physical Therapy, graduating as a teacher. Later he specialized in body-building, fitness, and was employed by the HEREDU GOLD GYM Fitness Center as a fitness instructor. Lali was also a very good nutritionist, but he remained close to his first love, karate.

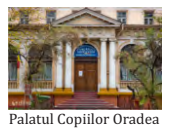

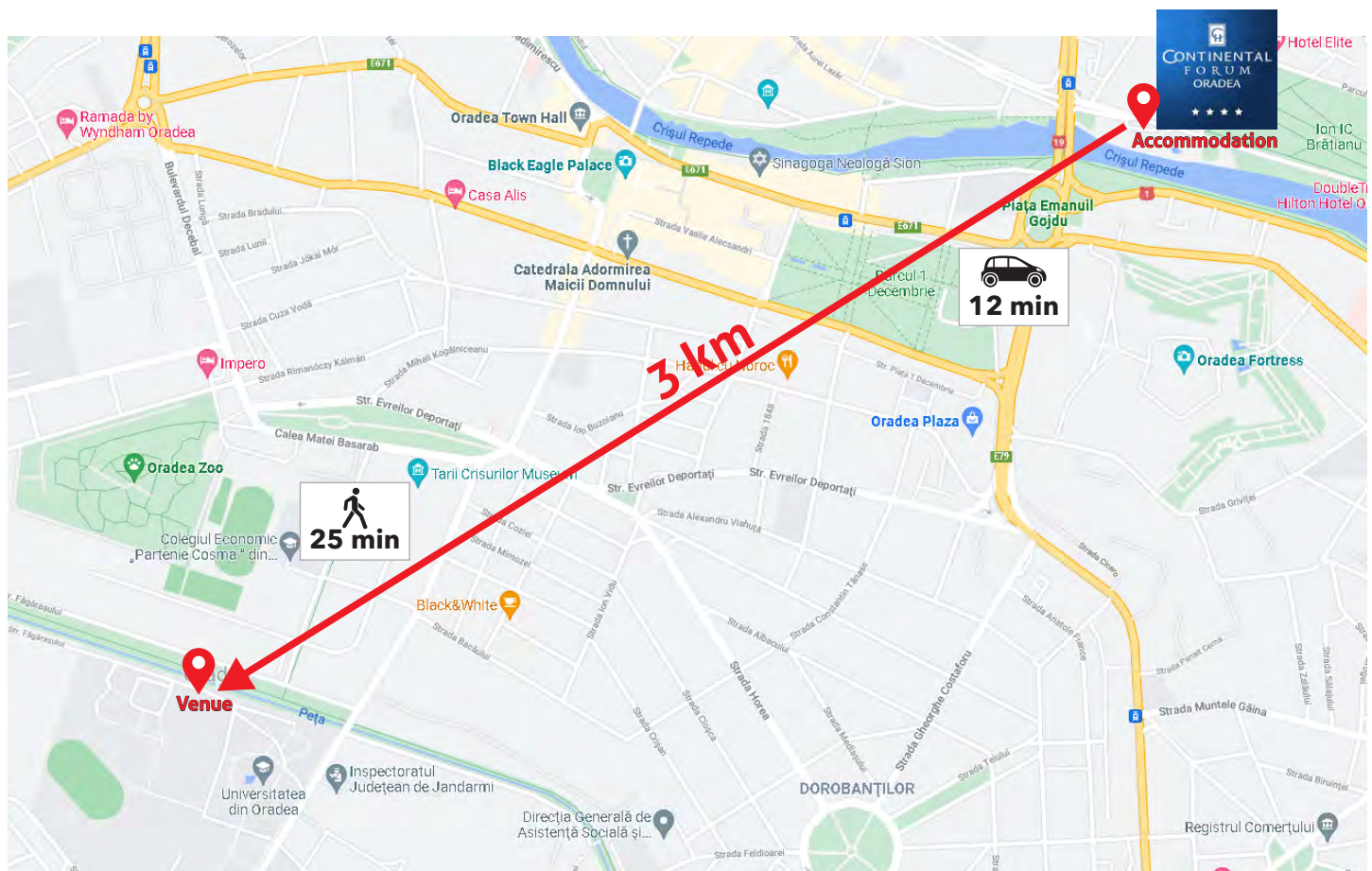

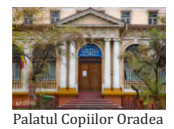

IMPORTANT!

- An athlete can participate in several categories of kata and kumite, from his age group or another age group, individually and teams.
- In case of a small number of people, the category can be merged.
- We reserve the right to merge the weight group and round robin system in case of a small number of people

Kata team: male and female (3 competitors)
Kumite team: male and female (3+1 competitors)

COMPETITION CATEGORIES: Individual and Team kata & kumite

RULES: Education-(WKF system-Modified)

-KUMITE RULES: There is no repechage, it is direct elimination, Kumite SHOBU (8 Points-Flag System) 5 Judges, WKF system

At the kumite team, if there are only two athletes, in the third match one of the two athletes can fight.

-KATA RULES (FLAG SYSTEM): There is no repechage, it is direct elimination applied, with following changes: kata categories from 4 to 13 years old, 2 competitors perform the kata simultaneously, except for medal matches. In medal matches aka and ao perform the kata separately.

Please consider the age of the competitors at the date of the tournament!

Rules:

Cadet, Junior, Senior, Masters categories:

For all kumite competitors body protector is optional. All competitors must have their own red and blue belts.

4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 years old categories:

1 minute for kumite age 4-7; 1,5 minute for kumite age 8-13; 2 minutes for cadets

KATA age 4-5, 6-7: at least 1 kata is required. KATA age 8-9, 10-11: at least 2 different kata are required. KATA age 12-13: at least 3 different kata are required. KATA Cadet, Junior, Senior, Masters: To absolute (Open-Free Kata) Can't repeat Kata. All Belts.

Registration:

Taking part in the official weigh-in **is not mandatory** but if the competitor has been registered in the wrong weight category, in case of protest during the competition, **the athlete will be disqualified.**

In children's and young cadets age 4-13, the randomly selected few have to do weigh-in. If **above the weight class by 1 kg** in karate pants and t-shirt, he / she **will be disqualified from the competition.**

If the competitors cadets, juniors, seniors and masters **is above the weight class by 1,5 kg** in karate pants and t-shirt, he / she **will be disqualified from the competition.**

On the day of the competition from 09.00 to 13.00, presenting the necessary certificates

All competitors must have:

- a "COMPETITIVE" sports doctor's license not older than 6 months
- BUDO PASS validated for 2022
- 2022 COMPETITION LICENSE

A competitor who does not meet one of the above conditions or does not have the correct weight according to the pre-submitted entry **will be disqualified!**

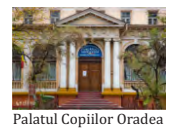

Protectors:

Gum shield, type red and blue mitts, shin pads and foot protection, for women chest protection, over 12 years mandatory.

Entry fee:

25€, -for one individual category

38€, -for two individual categories

12€, -for further entries/category

40€, -for one team kata category

40€, -for one team kumite category

20€, -the same team for further entries/category

Prizes:

1-3 places: medals and certificates, the winner of each category will receive a plaques and special award offered by the sponsors. Cups for the first 3 foreign clubs and national (Romanian Federations and Clubs Martial Arts Karate). Cups for the first 3 clubs of the Ministry of Education (Palaces and Clubs of Children)

-Draw: 14th October, 2022.

Protest:

The protest has to be submitted in writing (addition video filming must include the performance of both competitors in the kata and kumite tests, respectively the performance of the 5 referees. No protest is allowed without video footage from the match!) to the Referee Council in attention of the Chief referee of the Tournament and a protest fee of 100€ has to be deposited. If the protest is accepted by the Referee Council, the fee is going to be refunded.

Referees:

Referees are going to be delegated by the Organizing Committee. Foreign qualified referees are welcome. Please apply in writing to nominate your referee! The Organization Committee will not bear any responsibility for any kind of damages or losses.

Deadline for referees: 11 September 2022

Chief Referee: Babinszki Robert

Entry conditions:

Every competitor appears at his/her own responsibility. The organizer doesn't take responsibility for any eventual injuries. Coaches or team leaders must sign a responsibility statement! The coaches must wear a tracksuit and sneakers.

Responsibility:

The competitors and coaches are requested not to leave money and valuables unprotected on the scene of the championship, because the Organizing Committee does not take responsibility of the possible disappearance of the taken things (of all kinds of damages or losses).

Insurance:

It is recommended that all participants and members of delegations have their own insurance. The organizer of the competition is not responsible for any injuries or loss of personal belongings incurred by the competitors and participants. Athletes compete at the tournament on their own responsibility.

Attention:

All competitors must have their own red and blue belts.

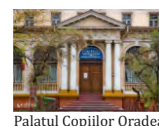
