Oradea

Oradea is one of the most important cities situated in north-west region of Romania. The city is the administrative seat of Bihor County and is located at 13 km away from the western border of Romania. It represents a prime central European location, constituting a vital communication hub, and is situated at a sensibly equal distance from the region's capitals: Bucharest (651 km), Vienna (518 km), Budapest (248 km), Bratislava (456 km) and Prague (676 km).

The city is nestled between the hills that separate and unify in a harmonious way with the Crișana Plain and the ends of the Apuseni Mountains. Located on the banks of the Crișul Repede river, the river that divides the city into almost two equal halves, it is the gateway to the Central and Western European world.

It is accessible by car/bus, train or airplane. Near to it are the resorts of Băile Felix and Băile 1 Mai. In the development process, Oradea incorporated the villages of Episcopia Bihor and Seleuș into its structure, currently aiming to incorporate the communes around the city, through the creation of the Oradea Metropolitan Area.

The first mention about Oradea city dated from the year of 1113, a diploma in the Zobor Benedictine abbey, the bishop's Sixtus name appears, but its roots are of Roman-Dacian origin, certifying the archaeological discoveries in the city of Salca and in the Felix Resort, that the Romans and Dacians were already established.

Throughout the Middle Ages, the city became a place of coexistence for an ethnic mosaic that helped to establish the ethnic composition of Oradea today: Romanian, Hungarian, Austrian, Slovak, Jewish, Ukrainian and Turkish.

Today Oradea is divided into 11 districts, which are placed around the Civic Center, the old city center.

Oradea has always been one of the most prosperous cities in Romania and one of the most important economic centers, in large part because of its proximity to the border with Hungary, thus becoming a gateway into the West.

Oradea is also an important historical-cultural center in Transylvania. By 1918, Oradea was part of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, and was governed by Budapest. City development, economic activities, architecture and housing, should be viewed in this context therefore.

The old city centre is one of the main tourist highlights in Oradea, as are the Băile Felix health spas, accessible by bus and located just outside the city. Nightlife in Oradea is very active. The historic city center is full of terraces, cafes, restaurants and clubs. Most of them are in the monument-buildings, the atmosphere making the experience unique.

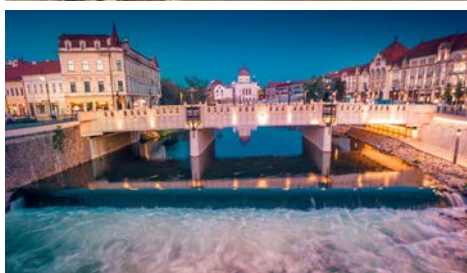
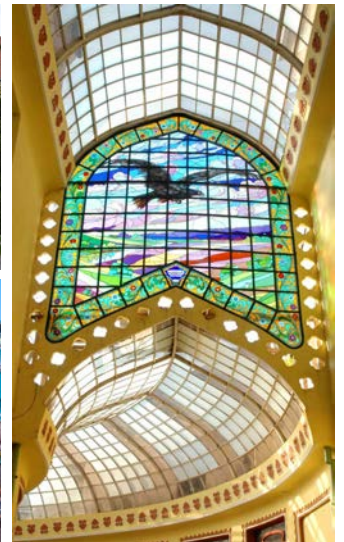




Oradea

Main tourist attractions:

- The Oradea State Theatre (Teatrul de Stat Oradea), also known as the Queen Mary Theatre (Teatrul Regina Maria) on Ferdinand Square in the heart of the city, completed in 1900.
- Baroque Palace of Oradea (today Muzeul ării Crișurilor). It was the Roman Catholic bishop's palace until 1945, when the Communist regime took the building into public ownership. It was returned to the Roman Catholic Church in 2003. Its collection includes many fossils of dinosaurs and birds from the bauxite mines at Cornet-Brusturi.
- Roman Catholic Basilica-Cathedral of the Assumption of Mary, or simply "Baroque Cathedral" ("Catedrala barocă") – the largest Baroque cathedral in Romania, and home to a skull relic and 2 statues of St. King Ladislaus I of Hungary.
- The Moon Church (Biserica cu Lună), a church with an astronomical clock depicting the phases of the moon, a unique feature in Europe.
- The Black Eagle Palace or Eagle Palace (Pasajul Vulturul Negru), shopping galleria, named after its famous stained-glass eagle located in the ceiling.
- Ady Endre Museum (Muzeul memorial Ady Endre) – a museum dedicated to one of the greatest Hungarian poets and a former resident of Oradea.
- Republicii Street (Str. Republicii), regarded as one of the most beautiful streets of Transylvania, displaying a great number of Art Nouveau style buildings.



The Oradea Fortress

It is indubitably one of the most important late-medieval architectural monuments in Transylvania and in the country. It became, in the 16th and 17th Centuries, one of the key pieces of the defensive system conceived and realized by the Habsburg Empire and the Transylvanian Principality against the Ottoman Empire, and thus a redoubtable bastion of Christian Europe faced with Muslim expansion, a position it held for two centuries, unanimously recognized by its contemporaries.

Sighisoara

199 km to Oradea

It is well-known that the famous son of Vlad Dracul, namely Vlad-Tepes Dracula was born and raised here. Sighisoara is a small city in the Transylvania region of Romania, with a history dating back to the 1100s. Back then, the Hungarian king was begging Saxons to move to this part of the world in order to help defend his borders. German craftsmen and artisans took him up on it, and what resulted is today a fairy-tale-like fortified city in the heart of Romania.

Bran Castle

470 km to Oradea

Surrounded by an aura of mystery and legend and perched high atop a 200-foot-high rock, Bran Castle owes its fame to its imposing towers and turrets as well as to the myth Dracula.





Băile Felix

Established in the 18th century, Baile Felix is currently Romania's largest health resort, open year-round. The thermal waters found here, very rich in oligominerals, are supplemented by sapropelic mud. This natural combination has proven helpful in easing the effects of rheumatism and some paralysis, as well as gynecological afflictions and nervous disorders.

You have the possibility to enjoy your time at Aqua Parks or thermal baths in some of the prestigious establishments like: Apolo, International, Thermal, Perla, etc.

You can take long walks in the forests and inhale some of that fresh air. You can also visit the famous water lily lake. You will just enjoy the quietness of the place.

Competition details

REGISTRATION/WEIGH-IN:

Taking part in the official weigh-in is not mandatory but if the competitor has been registered in the wrong weight category, in case of protest during the competition, the athlete will be disqualified.

Weight tolerance for all WSEKU kumite categories is a maximum of 1 kilogram.

In kumite categories, only the randomly selected few have to weigh in. If the competitor is above the weight class by 1,5 kg in karate pants and a t-shirt, he/she will be disqualified from the competition!

On the day of the competition from 09.00 to 13.00, presenting the necessary certificates

All competitors must have:

- a "COMPETITIVE" sports doctor's license not older than 6 months
- BUDO PASS validated for 2026
- 2026 COMPETITION LICENSE

A competitor who does not meet one of the above conditions or does not have the correct weight according to the pre-submitted entry will be disqualified! Coaches have to take responsibility to prove the age and grade of competitors (Budo Pass, ID etc.)

Please nominate one person per club on site!

ENTRY FEE:

- 40 €, for one individual category (4-13 years)
- 50 €, for one individual category (14 and over)
- € 140 per team

Please pay the entry fee with the registration together on the spot.

INSURANCE:

All participants and members of delegates must arrange their own medical insurance and personal travelling insurance. The organizer also assumes no liability for any health risks to the participant in connection with participation in the event. It is the responsibility of each participant to have their health checked by a doctor beforehand.

PRIZES:

1-3 places: medals and certificates, the winner of each category will receive a cup. In every category: International Championship, European Karate Championship, World Karate Championship Cups for the first 3 foreign clubs, international federations, associations, organizations, dojos, unions, universities, colleges, gymnasiums, schools, palaces and children's clubs.

DRAW: June 4, 2025.

PROTEST:

The protest has to be submitted in writing (addition video filming must include the performance of both competitors in the kata and kumite tests, respectively the performance of the 5 referees. No protest is allowed without video footage from the match!) to the Referee Council in attention of the Chief referee of the Tournament and a protest fee of 150€ has to be deposited. If the protest is accepted by the Referee Council, the fee is going to be refunded.

The protest must be submitted after the match is finished.

Referees are going to be delegated by the World Sport Education Karate Union (WSEKU). Foreign qualified referees are welcome. Please apply in writing to nominate your referee!

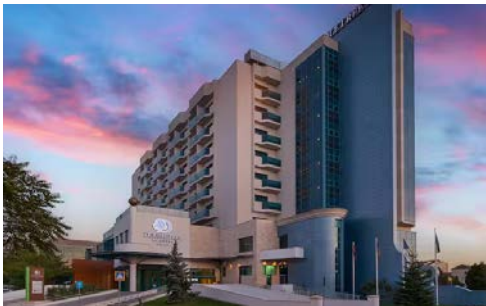

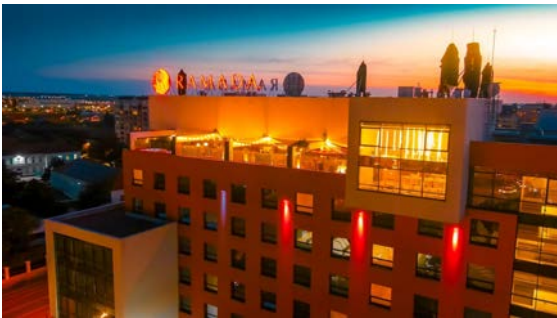

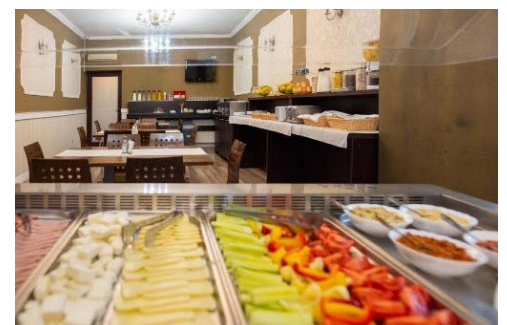
